What is Worry-Free Business Security Services?

Trend Micro™ Worry-Free™ Business Security Services (WFBSS) is a hosted service for small businesses that protects multiple PCs and notebooks located in or out of the office from viruses and other threats. You can centrally manage security from anywhere without adding a server or installing server software. Trend Micro hosts and updates the service for you.

Worry-Free Business Security Services features:

- Protects multiple Windows, MAC and Android devices from a single, business solution
- Stops viruses, spyware, and other Web threats before they reach the device
- · Generates overall security reports
- Provides a centralized Web console, accessible from anywhere (no server required)

Can I try Worry-Free Business Security Services for a while?

Yes, you can try it for 30 days! And if you buy the full version, your settings will be automatically migrated.

How can I activate Worry-Free Business Security Services?

When you buy WFBSS, you will receive either a Registration Key or an Activation Code.

Visit https://clp.trendmicro.com/. If you have an existing Trend Micro account, sign in with those credentials. If not, create one.

Note: If you have a WFBSS evaluation account, log onto the Customer Licensing Portal (CLP) with those same credentials.

- Pollow the onscreen instructions to register WFBSS.
 - If you have an evaluation account: after registering WFBSS, you can now migrate to the full service. This will migrate previously entered information and settings to your new account.
- 3 Use the URL and logon credentials that we will send you by email to access the WFBSS console.

How do I get started?

Visit WFBSS web console at https://wfbs-svc.trendmicro.com/ and log on.

Now you can:

Go to Devices > Add Devices. You will be guided through the process to download and deploy the WFBSS Agent to client computers.
